

BIMSTEC MEMBER STATES MADE A JOINT CALL ON MODI

PM stresses on BIMSTEC's role as engine for economic, social growth

NEW DELHI: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday reaffirmed India's commitment to seven-nation grouping BIMSTEC and stressed on its role as an engine for economic and social growth.

The foreign ministers of the BIMSTEC member states made a joint call on Modi on the second and final day of their retreat in Delhi. The Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC), brings together seven countries of South and Southeast Asia for multifaceted cooperation. Besides India, the BIMSTEC comprises Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Myanmar, Thailand, Nepal and Bhutan.

"Glad to meet BIMSTEC Foreign Ministers. Discussed ways to strengthen regional cooperation, including connectivity, energy, trade, health, agriculture, science, security and

people-to-people exchanges. Conveyed full support to Thailand for a successful Summit," Modi said on X.

A readout by the PMO said Modi reaffirmed India's commitment to a peaceful, prosperous, resilient and safe BIMSTEC

region and highlighted its significance to India's 'Neighbourhood First and Look East Policies as well as in its SAGAR vision.

"The PM had fruitful discussions with the group of ministers on further strengthening the regional cooperation in diverse

areas including connectivity, energy, trade, health, agriculture, science, security and people to people exchanges," it said.

"He stressed on the role of BIMSTEC as an engine for economic and social growth," the readout noted.

It said Modi expressed India's full support to Thailand for the upcoming BIMSTEC Summit to be held in September.

India hosted the BIMSTEC foreign ministers' retreat to review various initiatives to expand cooperation among the grouping's member nations.

In his inaugural address at the retreat, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar called on the grouping to infuse new energies, resources and a fresh commitment to bolster cooperation.

India has been making concerted efforts to make BIMSTEC a vibrant forum for regional cooperation as initiatives under SAARC (South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation) were not moving forward for a variety of reasons.

India has been cooperating with the countries of the Indian Ocean region under the broader policy framework of SAGAR or Security and Growth for all in the Region.

PAWAR-BACKED NOMINEE LOSES

After LS setback, Mahayuti shines in Maharashtra council polls

MUMBAI: In a morale-boosting victory for 'Mahayuti' in Maharashtra ahead of assembly polls, the ruling alliance on Friday won all the nine seats it contested in the biennial elections to 11 Legislative Council seats, but the opposition MVA faced a setback as a candidate backed by Sharad Pawar's party lost.

In the results announced in the evening for the high-stakes polls held earlier in the day, where 12 candidates were in the fray for 11 seats, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) won five seats, while Chief Minister Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena and the Ajit Pawar-led Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) bagged two each.

All three parties are constituents of the ruling Mahayuti (grand alliance) which performed poorly in the recent Lok Sabha polls, winning just 17 seats out of the total 48 in Maharashtra.

From the opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA), Milind Narvekar, a close aide of Shiv

Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray, and Congress candidate Pradnya Satav won the elections.

However, Peasants and Workers' Party (PWP) candidate Jayant Patil, who was supported by Sharad Pawar-led Nationalist Congress Party (SP), lost the polls, dealing a blow to the MVA.

The Shiv Sena (UBT), the Congress, the NCP (SP) and some smaller parties are mem-

bers of the MVA, which had put up an impressive show in the Lok Sabha elections, winning 30 seats.

Establishing 'Gram Nyayalayas' would provide access to affordable justice: SC

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Friday said establishing 'Gram Nyayalayas' would help in providing affordable and speedy justice to the citizens at their doorsteps and also reduce the huge pendency of cases in trial courts.

An Act passed by Parliament in 2008 provided for the setting up of 'Gram Nyayalayas' at the grassroots level for providing access to justice to citizens and to ensure that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to anyone by reason of social, economic or other disabilities.

The apex court directed the chief secretaries of states and registrar generals of the high courts to file affidavits within six weeks pointing out



the details regarding establishment and functioning of 'Gram Nyayalayas', including about infrastructure made available for them.

A bench of Justices B R Gavai and K V Viswanathan passed the order after advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for petitioner NGO National Federation of Societies for Fast Justice and others, said that 16 years after passing of the Act,

only 264 Gram Nyayalayas were functional.

The plea was filed in the apex court in 2019 seeking a direction to the Centre and all states for taking steps to set up 'Gram Nyayalayas' under the supervision of the top court.

It has said that sections 5 and 6 of the Gram Nyayalayas Act, 2008, provide that state government in consultation with the high court will appoint a 'Nyayadhikari' for each 'Gram Nyayalaya', who will be a person eligible to be appointed as a judicial magistrate of the first class. During the hearing, Bhushan said the Act came into being in 2008 and a minimum of 6,000 Gram Nyayalayas should have been established by now.

Special status demand triggers political slugfest in Bihar

PATNA: The ruling NDA in Bihar and the opposition Mahagathbandhan on Friday crossed swords over the demand for special status to the state, which seems to have intensified ahead of the Parliament's budget session.

The demand was first made soon after the creation of Jharkhand robbed the state of its mineral wealth, though the Centre has been of the view that the grant of special status was no longer possible since the provision was scrapped by the 14th Finance Commission.

What is PM Modi's position on 'billionaire tax', what will be India's stand at G20, asks Cong

NEW DELHI: With the issue of "billionaire tax" being taken up with G20 countries by a group of former presidents and prime ministers, the Congress on Friday asked what is Prime Minister Narendra Modi's position on such a tax and what will be India's stand when the matter is discussed at the G20 meet later this month.

Congress general secretary, in-charge communications, Jairam Ramesh, said all over the world, there is a growing consensus that billionaires must

pay their fair share of taxes. "As proposed by Brazil -- which now holds the annual rotational G20 Presidency -- and endorsed by France, Spain, South Africa, and Germany, the world is moving towards a

2 per cent wealth tax on these billionaires," he said in a post on X. "India has 167 dollar billionaires. A 2 per cent wealth tax would raise 1.5 lakh crores each year - almost 0.5 per cent of our GDP. This could pay for schools, hospitals, renewable energy, and many more essential investments in the future of our country," Ramesh said. "What is the non-biological PM's position on a 'billionaire tax'? What will be India's position when it will be discussed at the G20 meet in Rio de Janeiro later this month?" the Congress leader said.

'No question of including controversial portion of any script'

NEW DELHI: Amid a row over the proposal to teach Manusmriti to law students of Delhi University, Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan on Friday said there is no question of including any controversial portion of any script in the curriculum.

While noting that Delhi University Vice Chancellor Yogesh Singh had rejected the proposal to teach Manusmriti to law students on Thursday itself, Pradhan said the government is committed to upholding the true spirit of the Constitution.

'WINNING AND LOSING HAPPEN IN LIFE' Rahul Gandhi asks people not to be nasty towards Smriti Irani

NEW DELHI: Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi on Friday urged people to refrain from using derogatory language and being nasty towards former Union minister Smriti Irani or any other leader.

His remarks come amid some people taking digs at Irani after she vacated her official bungalow following her defeat in the Lok Sabha polls to Congress' Kishori Lal Sharma in Uttar Pradesh's Amethi. "Winning and losing happen in life. I urge everyone to refrain from using derogatory language and being nasty towards Smt. Smriti Irani or any other leader for that mat-

ter," Gandhi said on X. "Humiliating and insulting people is a sign of weakness, not strength," the former Congress president said. The BJP's IT department head Amit Malviya hit back at Gandhi, accusing him of putting out a disingenuous message after "unleashing" Congress leaders

like "a pack of wolves" on her. Malviya said on X, "This is the most disingenuous message, ever. After unleashing Congress leaders, like a pack of wolves, on the woman who defeated him in Amethi and smashed his arrogance to smithereens, this is rich. All this gibberish doesn't take away from the fact that Smt Smriti Irani forced Balak Budhhi to abandon Amethi."

Irani vacated her official bungalow at 28 Tughlak Crescent in Lutyens' Delhi, weeks after she was defeated by Sharma, a close aide of the Gandhi family, from Amethi parliamentary seat with a margin of over 1.6 lakh votes.

Historic judgment by Allahabad HC: First verdict delivered in English, Hindi, Sanskrit

LUCKNOW: In a landmark initiative, the Allahabad High Court has made history by pronouncing a judgment in three languages simultaneously: English, Hindi, and Sanskrit. This unprecedented move is being hailed as a significant step in making judicial proceedings more inclusive and accessible.

The court addressed a petition concerning the enforcement of interim alimony ordered by a family court under Section 125 of the Criminal Procedure Code (CrPC). The High Court ruled that such orders must be implemented and clarified that an application under Section 482 CrPC is not maintainable for this purpose. Instead, the petitioner should seek enforcement under Section 128 of the CrPC by approaching the family court.

The decision was rendered by Justice Shiv Shanker

Prasad while dismissing a petition filed by Kanchan Rawat, who married Baijlal Rawat on December 1, 2009. Her family reportedly spent between 7 to 8 lakh rupees on the wedding. However, she faced harassment for dowry at her in-laws' home and was eventually forced to return to her parents' house. On November 26, 2011, she gave birth to her son, Gaurav.

Rawat's wife sought alimony from her husband, but

when he failed to provide it, she filed a case in the family court of Ghazipur. The family court ordered Baijlal Rawat to pay interim alimony of Rs. 4,000 per month under Section 125 CrPC, which he complied with initially. However, an outstanding amount of Rs. 80,000 remained unpaid. The court subsequently ordered Mr. Rawat to pay the balance in installments of Rs. 10,000 per month. When this directive was not followed, Mrs.

Rawat filed a petition under Section 482 CrPC in the High Court, seeking enforcement of the payment.

High Court's Ruling The opposition contested the maintainability of the petition, arguing that Rawat's wife should seek relief under Section 128 CrPC. The court upheld this objection and dismissed the petition, advising Rawat's wife to approach the family court for enforcement of the alimony order.
