

Putin ends BRICS summit that sought to expand Russia's global clout


KAZAN: Russian President Vladimir Putin on Thursday closed a summit of the BRICS bloc of developing economies, praising its role as a counterbalance to what he called the West's "perverse methods".

The three-day summit in the city of Kazan was attended by leaders or representatives of 36 countries, highlighting the failure of US-led efforts to isolate Russia over its actions in Ukraine.

The conflict came up repeatedly at the meeting, which saw the first visit to Russia from UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres in more than two years and drew an angry reaction from Kyiv.

Guterres called for "a just peace" in Ukraine, in line with the UN Charter, international law and General Assembly resolutions.

He also urged an immediate end to the fighting in Gaza, Lebanon and Sudan.
