Action is needed now, Guterres said. Having endured years of armed conflict and related violence, the people of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Yemen, northeast Nigeria and South Sudan are again facing the specter of heightened food insecurity...

Everybody is very preoccupied by COVID and the virus, Lowcock said. But it is not the virus that's creating most of the carnage. It is other things, and we need to focus on the things that will really cause the biggest loss of life.

He said a lot of effort has gone into things like providing personal protective equipment, public information campaigns on the virus, water and sanitation campaigns, all of which are good things.

In northeast Nigeria's Borno, Adamawa and Yobe states, he said, alarming levels of food insecurity and hunger have arisen largely as a result of the actions of extremists affiliated with armed groups.

Suspected gas blast kills 17 people in B'desh mosque

DHAKA: A suspected gas pipeline explosion at a mosque in Bangladesh killed 17 people and injured dozens as worshippers were about to end their prayers, officials said on Saturday.

Fire officials said gas that accumulated from a leak in a pipeline running underneath the mosque likely triggered the explosion. "We primarily suspect that gas leaked from the pipeline and accumulated inside since the windows were closed.
