

NEW DELHI: Laishram Sayon Metei has become the first wrestler from Manipur to get noticed at the national-level by making it to the final of the boys' 50kg Greco-Roman competition at the inaugural Khelo India School Games at the KD Jadhav Stadium here. This is certainly a first of sorts for a state that has so far produced numerous boxers, footballers and weightlifters. The first impressions of the youngster do not, in any way, give away the enormity of his feats. Hailing from a little village close to Imphal, Sayon has made a mark in a sport that is not the first you would associate with Manipur. In 2016, he represented India at the Asian and World Cadet Championships in 46kg Greco Roman competitions. He managed only a modest finish of 13th and 11th respectively but has shown his determination. Sayon's tryst with wrestling began in 2013. Within a year of taking up this sport, he had already won a 46kg silver at the 2014 SGFI competition. Back then, he competed freestyle. Now he has reached the 50kg Greco Roman finals at the inaugural Khelo India School Games where he was to face Haryana's Pradeep Vinod.

Chung sets sights on Grand Slam after remarkable Australia run



SEOUL: Rising tennis star Chung Hyeon believes he is on course to become South Korea's first tennis Grand Slam winner, as he recovers from his remarkable but gruelling run to the Australian Open semi-finals.

Chung, 21, was the surprise package in Melbourne as he stormed his way to the last four, but had to retire while trailing defending champion Roger Federer 1-6 2-5 because of painful blisters.

Federer went on to win the event — the Swiss master's 20th Grand Slam — but Chung said Friday he has set his sights on winning his first. "I've not set any specific target (for the French Open) but I will be able to win a Grand Slam tournament some day in the future," he said.

Chung uploaded a horrific picture of his blistered foot after the Federer clash on his Instagram account, sparking a flood of messages from fans praising him for his courage.

"I've seldom played so many games unrelentingly and my feet reached their limits," he said. "My doctor says the blistered feet are curing well due to my young age and I will be able to start training next week," he said.

Chung said he was already looking forward to the next Grand Slam, the French Open in late May, which is unique among the four major events for using clay courts.
