First ship carrying Ukrainian grain leaves the port of Odesa

The corn will head to Lebanon, a Mideast nation in grips of what World Bank has described as one of the world's worst financial crises in over 150 years

ANKARA: The first ship carrying Ukrainian grain set off from the port of Odesa on Monday under a deal brokered by the United Nations and Turkey that is expected to release large stores of Ukrainian crops to foreign markets and ease a growing food crisis.

The Sierra Leone-flagged cargo ship Razoni left Odesa carrying over 26,000 tonnes of corn destined for Lebanon.

The first grain ship since Russian aggression has left port, said Ukraine's Minister of Infrastructure Oleksandr Kubrakov on Twitter, posting a video of the long vessel sounding its horn as its slowly headed out to sea.

Posting separately on Facebook, Kubrakov said Ukraine is the fourth-largest corn exporter in the world, so the possibility of exporting it via ports is a colossal success in ensuring global food security.

In an interview with Turkey's state-run Anadolu Agency, Akar warned that the global food crisis threatened to trigger a serious wave of migration from Africa to Europe and to Turkey.

Lebanon, a Mideast nation in the grips of what the World Bank has described as one of the world's worst financial crises in more than 150 years.

A 2020 explosion at its main port in Beirut shattered its capital city and destroyed grain silos there, a part of which collapsed following a weeklong fire just Sunday.

The Turkish defense ministry said other ships would also depart Ukraine's ports through the safe corridors in line with deals signed in Istanbul on July 22, but did not provide further details.

Russia and Ukraine signed separate agreements with Turkey and the U.N. clearing the way for Ukraine one of the world's key breadbaskets to export 22 million tons of grain and other agricultural goods that have been stuck in Black Sea ports because of Russia's invasion.

China's PLA celebrates 95th anniversary

BEIJING: China's People's Liberation Army (PLA), the world's largest military, on Monday celebrated the 95th anniversary, flexing its muscles to deter US House Speaker Nancy Pelosi's purported plan to visit Taiwan that has fuelled tension with Beijing.

Pelosi confirmed on Sunday she will lead a congressional delegation to Singapore, Malaysia, South Korea and Japan but was conspicuously silent about a possible stopover at Taiwan, the self-governing island that China claims as part of its mainland.

The proposed visit drew a fiery warning from President Xi Jinping in his last Thursday's phone conversation with his US counterpart Joe Biden, asserting that "those who play with fire will perish by it."

Beijing sees official American contact with Taiwan as encouragement to make its decades-old de facto independence permanent.

Coinciding with its 95th Army Day celebrations on Monday, the two-million-strong PLA highlighted some of its latest achievements in weaponry and equipment development and realistic combat preparations to warn "Taiwan independence" secessionist and external interfering forces.

The PLA revealed new progress has been made in its advanced weaponry and equipment, including its hypersonic missile, amphibious assault ship, aerial tanker and large destroyers

State broadcaster China Central Television (CCTV) on Saturday released a video titled "The capabilities of the Chinese troops shown in 81 seconds" showing the launch of a DF-17 hypersonic missile from a transporter erector launcher on a highway in a desert. The missile can hit stationary and moving targets in the South China Sea, the Taiwan Straits and North-east Asia, including aircraft carriers, Global Times report said.

Fuel tanker truck catches fire in Libya; 9 dead, 76 injured

CAIRO: A fuel tanker truck caught fire and exploded on Monday in central Libya, killing at least nine people and injuring 76 others, health authorities said.

The incident took place in the central town of Bent Bayya when the tanker truck overturned before catching fire and exploding, the state-run Libya News agency reported.

Lanka's SC extends overseas travel ban on Rajapaksa brothers till Aug 4

COLOMBO: Sri Lanka's Supreme Court on Monday extended until August 4 the overseas travel ban on former prime minister Mahinda Rajapaksa and his younger brother and former finance minister Basil Rajapaksa, who are widely blamed for the current economic crisis in the island nation.

A five judge bench of the Supreme Court led by Chief Justice Jayantha Jayasuriya announced the Monday's decision in a petition filed against the brothers of former President Gotabaya Rajapaksa by a group including former Chairman of the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Chandra Jayaratne, former Sri Lanka swimming champion Julian Bolling, Jehan Kanagaratna and Transparency International Sri Lanka.

The direction was issued when a motion related to the petition requesting the court to issue an order for an investigation against the people responsible for the current economic crisis came up on Monday.
